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➤ PAPER FORMAT:

For this second step the technical committee approved the submission paper at 2 (two) formats:

- Final paper: 5-10 pages **or**
- Extended Abstract: 2-4 pages

The paper must be written in English.

FINAL PAPERS

Complete projects must have between 5 and 10 pages and be submitted **only in English**, in accordance with the **template of the event**.

File: The file must be sent in **PDF format** and the maximum size allowed is 3.500kb (3MB).

Hint: Before inserting pictures or graphs, make sure that the resolution is between 72 and 96dpi.

Authors who choose this option, if accepted, will have the paper published in the IBP online library, with ISSN registration and evaluated for indexing in the Scopus/Elsevier database (the database of citations and scientific literature summary).

EXTENDED ABSTRACT

The extended abstracts must be written in such way that the reader may identify its content and main conclusions.

2. Section Headings (Times New Roman, 12, Bold, Left Aligned)

All section headings must be written in Times New Roman, font 12, in bold type and left aligned.

Arabic numerals followed by dots must be used to number sections. All words must be capitalized except for prepositions. The heading of a section must be two lines below the previous text and use the same left margin as the following one.

2.1 Subsection Headings (Times New Roman, 12, Bold, Left Aligned)

All subsection headings must be written in Times New Roman, font 10, in bold type and left aligned. All words must be capitalized except for prepositions. The heading of a subsection must be one line below the previous text and right above the following one.

3. Figures (Times New Roman, 12, Bold, Left Aligned)




Figure 1. Program window (Times New Roman, 10)

Each figure shown in the text must bear a title and be numbered in Arabic numerals. Figures should be centered, and referred to in the text as follows: "Figure 1 indicates...". The captions must be equally centered below each figure. A line must be skipped between the figure, the captions and the body of the text.

Figure should be introduced as close as possible to the place where they are mentioned in the text. They can be colored, however, we request the authors' attention to use only **colored heavy lines**. The maximum size allowed is 3,400 x 1,700.

4. Tables (Times New Roman, 12, Bold, Left Aligned)

Tables must also be numbered in Arabic numerals and bear a title. They should be centered, and referred to in the text as follows: "The corresponding data can be found in Table 1." Captions must be centered right above each table. The information contained in the tables must be written in Times New Roman, font 10. A line must be skipped between the table, the captions and the body of the text. The border should be as in the example below.

- Formal session presentation of papers with economic nature and general interest to a large audience;
- Time: 15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion;
- PowerPoint Presentation: written in English (Simultaneous translation will be available for the languages Portuguese/English/Portuguese) **or**;

- Informal forum for direct contact between authors and delegates in technical matters of specific focus. They may be scientific and/or cutting-edge topics of great interest but aimed at a specific audience;
- Time: 15 minutes for presentation;
- PowerPoint Presentation: written in English (Simultaneous translation will be available for the languages Portuguese/English/Portuguese).

➤ **SYSTEM INSTRUCTIONS (STEP BY STEP):**

To begin, access the IBP paper system and on the menu chose **SEND PAPER**. This form will be divided as:

PAPER SUBMISSION FORM – PAPER DETAILS:

- Paper Country
- Paper Title
- Block: Select the topic of the event
- Preferred presentation
- Abstract
- File (in PDF).

Note 1: The abstract must have 100 to 500 words.

Note 2: The paper file must be according to the template available.

Note 3: The Technical Committee will classify the presentation format of your paper as oral or digital poster.

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- **Attention: Each author must fill in and sign this document and also access the status of paper INDIVIDUALLY and sent through the system, in PDF format, until May 23th, 2019.**
- To upload the form the authors must access “status of paper”, choose the title of the paper, agree to the Terms and Conditions and upload the file.

➤ **STATUS OF PAPER:**

All the authors must access this menu in order to:

- Download and Upload the “copyright form”;
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- Check the date, time, format oral/poster and instructions/template the presentation.

➤ **AUTHORS UP DATE FORM:**

All the authors must complete their data into the system in order to complete the paper registration.

- All authors that will attend Rio Pipeline 2019 must register;
- In order to have the approved paper included in the Congress' final program and published in the IBP's online Library, it is necessary the registration at least of the **presenting author** of the paper until **July 31th, 2019**;
- Registration fees and information on how to register for the Congress will be available in the website;
- Be advised that your paper will not be included in the final program and proceedings of the event, unless presenting author of the project is properly registered in accordance the schedule.
